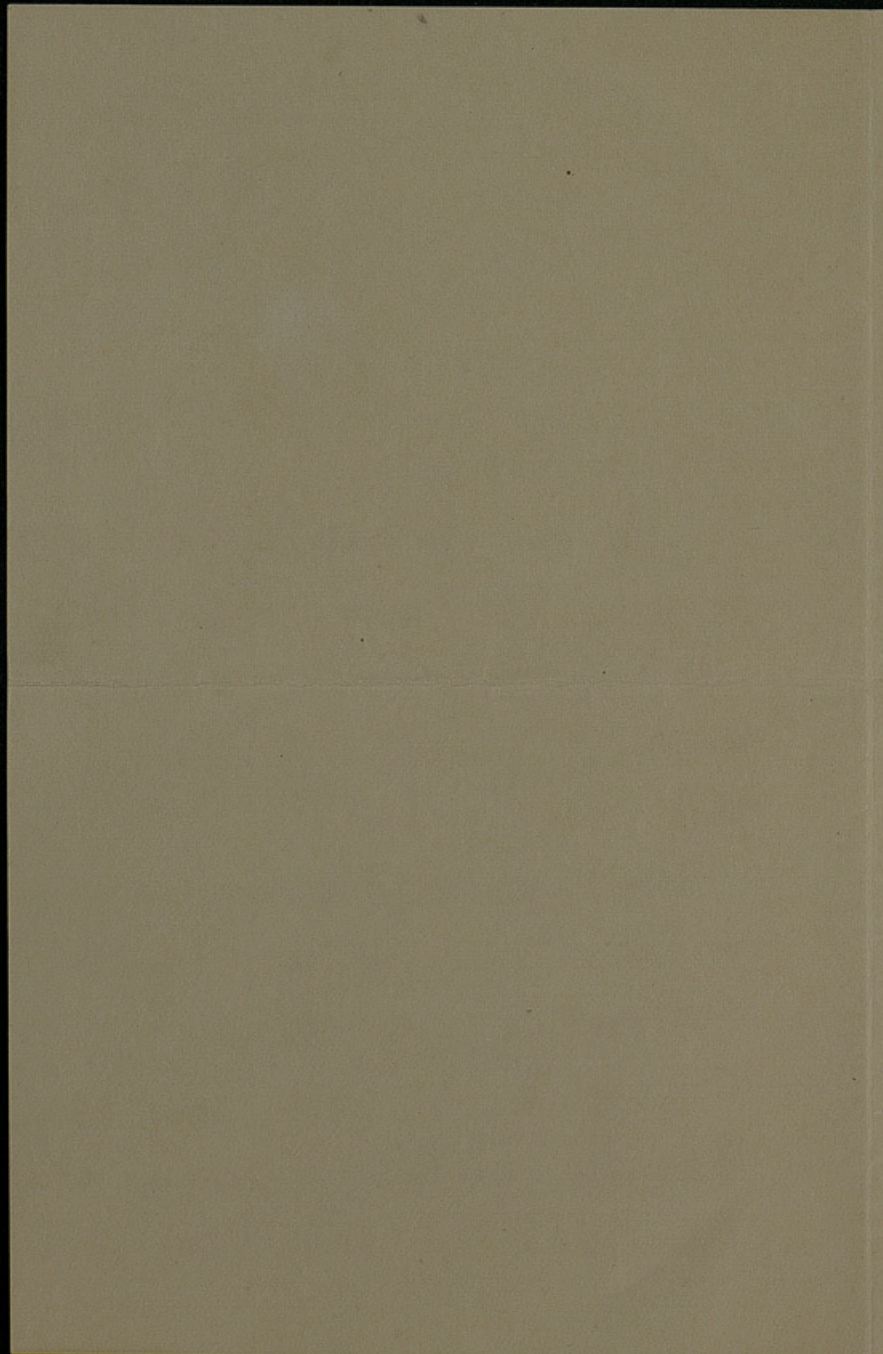

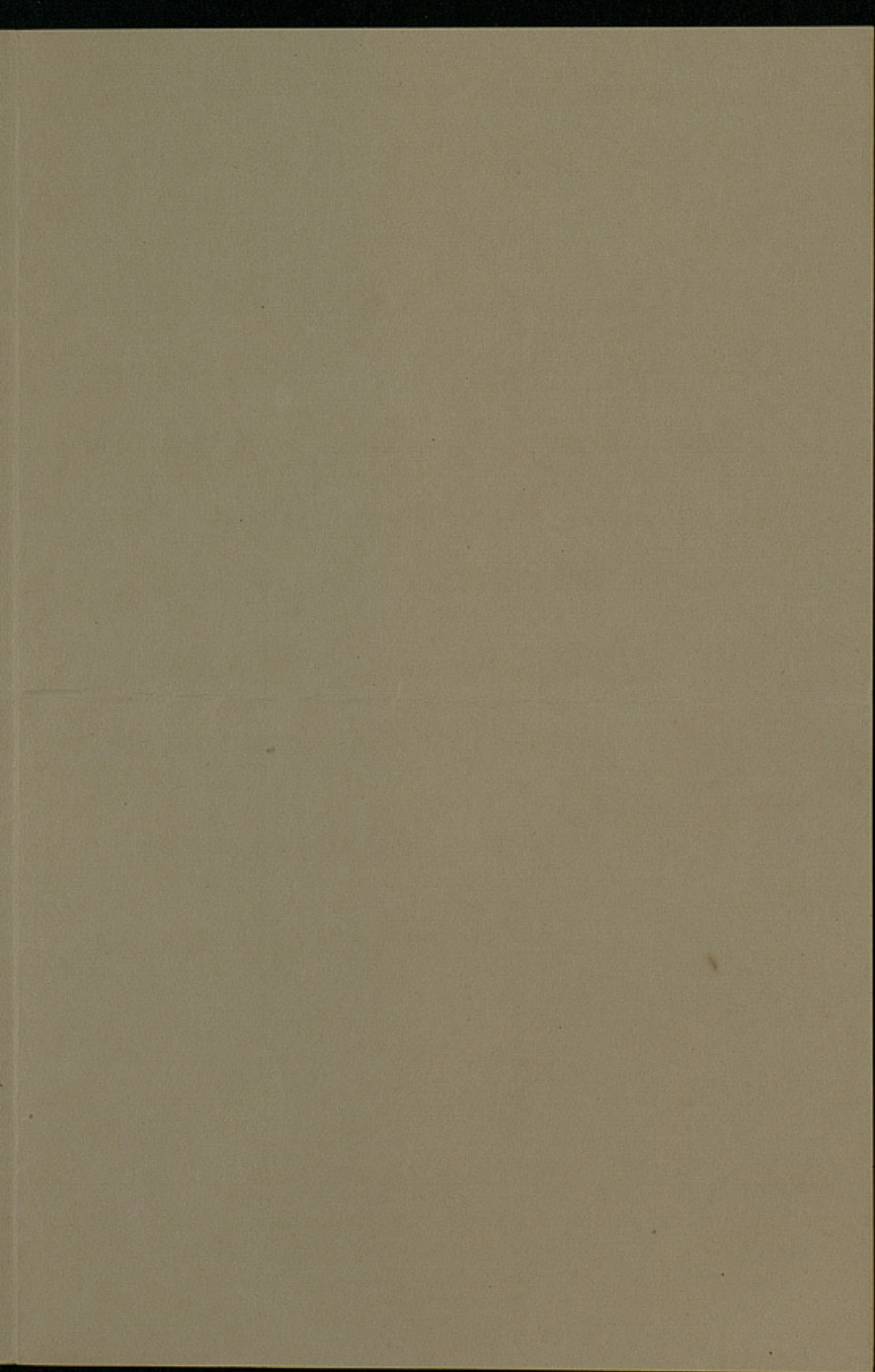
My Dear Sir,
