My dear colleague:

Doctor Dodge has handed me your letters of November 24 in regard to exchanges of the Torrey Botanical Club with your Bulletin, the "Boletim da Sociedade Broteriana". I happen to have been one of the associate editors of the publications of the Torrey Botanical Club for the past 36 years and am more or less familiar with its policy in regard to exchanges. About 1901, when the Club discontinued sending your Society its "Bulletin", the three libraries of the three institutions, The New York Botanical Garden, The Torrey Botanical Club, and the Botanical Department of Columbia University, were consolidated and in order to avoid unnecessary duplications in the matter of exchanges, a general plan was formulated under which the Sociedade Broteriana was to receive the "Bulletin of The New York Botanical Garden" in exchange for your "Boletim". I think that you have that series complete (54 numbers) as we now have yours with the exception of Volume 9 of the second series. While the "Bulletin of The New York Botanical Garden" has not been officially discontinued, it has not been published for the last two years. On account of this, we are now sending you the monthly Journal of The New York Botanical Garden, which we trust you are kindly willing to continue to receive as an exchange for your "Boletim da Sociedade".
